Behavioral Expression Monitoring

Recognizing and supporting the community member as a whole person is the best route to an Individualized Focus. Our Community members may have "behavioral expressions". The reasons behind behavioral expressions are sometimes complex. Being Individually Focused, we seek out to uncover the reason behind these expressions. We will use a personalized approach instead of or along side a pharmacologic one.

Home Again understands that family communication is of the utmost importance. With Monthly communication from the community you can ensure that your loved one is Thriving to their fullest.



Secure Environment

Home Again Provides the comfort of home, with safety and security of 24 hour on-site care. We provide you or your loved on with:

- 24 hour awake staff
- RN on staff
- Monitored Building Security System
- Wireless resident call system
- Delayed Egress Door

Common Questions



What if I see another community member in my loved ones room?

Let a staff know, please keep in mind they are not acting with malice.



What if I see a verbal/physical altercation between two residents?

At times Community Members can misinterpret what is going around them and become upset. Remain calm toward the resident and notify a staff member to diffuse the situation.



I came to visit my mom and we sat next to a Community Member who had a strong body odor, is he not being taken care of?

Diminished senses, fears, and daily routine can make personal care a struggle for those with dementia. Our staff are diligent with attempts to direct, and redirect when it comes to personal care. We celebrate the successes throughout the day, small or large.



My mother always misplaces items, what happens if she loses her wedding ring?

Home Again suggests that you safely store all valuables that are of monetary and intrinsic value. Purchasing a similar, less expensive, substitute can help maintain that familiarity.



I normally eat supper with my mom but today I ate breakfast with her and noticed that there were multiple residents that were not at the meal. Why is that?

It is important to maintain routine, some Community Member normally sleep in. When they are ready for their meal we will make it fresh while also offering high-calorie snacks.



What do I do if another community member, or my loved one, approaches me and asks to go home?

The Home Again staff are here to assist, we are trained to redirect in a positive manner.



My parent will call or yell out at times, not only is this embarrassing, will we get in trouble. How can I get them to stop?

When this happens, please remain calm. Our staff are trained to respond empathetically and professionally to "Behavioral Expression" communication.



Why are there no "big" group activities?

Home Again values an individually focused approach. Ensuring community members are engaged with purpose is vital. Individual needs and capabilities drive activity types.



Why are there "toys" setting around in the Memory Care?

These are tools to engage our Community Members, calm them when they are upset, or help them reminisce about a memory through sensory or tactile stimulation.



Whenever I visit their room is a mess. Sometimes it looks like their room has only been half cleaned. Is a housekeeper is cleaning it?

Rest assured the Housekeeper is cleaning their room. Housekeeping will clean resident room with respect and proper timing. At times residents wish to not have anyone intruding in their room, so a portion may be cleaned while they are at a meal and finished later.

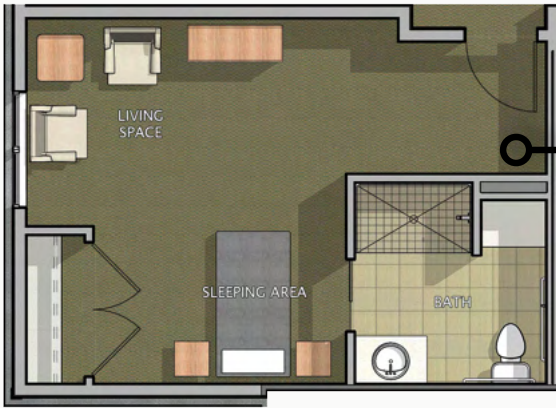
